On November 28 a report was received of vandalism to a vehicle on Anderson Road. The passenger side window had been broken out. - Huskvarna chain saw, owner applied number starting with A on handle area
- Echo gas powered drill, owner applied number starting with A on handle area
- Hand line ropes
- Boomers

On December 3 a report was received of a burglary to a residence on Dean King Road. The front door had been kicked in and the back door, which was always locked, was found to be unlocked. Nothing was found to be missing. Owners thought they may have come home while the perpetrators were still in the residence, and they fled out the back door.
